Our emphasis is very much on promoting quality of life and person centred care as well as supporting loved ones of that person. The care is delivered by experienced Health Care Assistants 365 days a year day or night. Our senior registered nurses are available Mon-Fri and are part of the primary care team working across the community. This past year our Wellbeing services which included Drop In's and Dementia walking football, have all sadly been suspended. We have adjusted our services to allow us to respond to the needs as best as we can and as safely as we can.

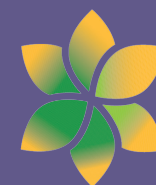
Our Family Support Service is a confidential listening service for bereaved adults within our catchment area who need emotional support and someone to talk to, at a time that suits their needs. We also offer support for those caring for loved ones with a life limiting illness, and our trained volunteers understand the feelings of grief and loss associated with bereavement.

This service is free of charge and there is no need to have had any prior contact with the hospice. People wishing to access the service can contact us directly or via healthcare professional. Initial contact will be from our Family Support coordinator to have a chat about your support needs and plan ongoing support. This will be delivered via our dedicated volunteers with extensive training and backgrounds in bereavement support. Appointments will be predominantly telephone consultations.
